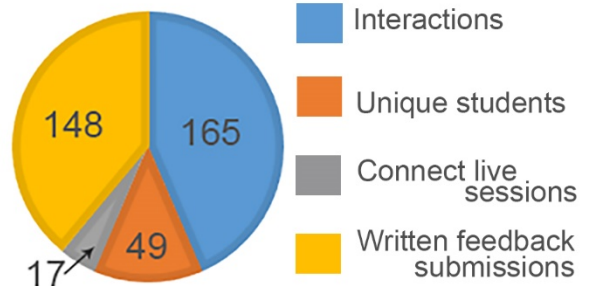

This book is the scarce British edition of Mrs. Maclurcan's Cookery Book based on the 3rd Australian edition with adjustments for British fish, but retaining recipes for Australian ingredients and products. There are 1,030 numbered recipes, menus and other items, including instructions for "Australian soup", "Pawpaw preserve", "Roast wallaby" and "Prickly pear jelly". It also features sections on tinned fish, which carried great prestige during the early 20th century.
